Changes of the judges are possible, individual breeds may be downgraded according to the number of their entries

General provisions

The dog show is organized according to the dog show rules of the FCI and ČMKU. Only dogs entered in FCI-accepted stud books are allowed to take part at the show. Certain dog have to reached the age required for entering the desired class on the show day at the latest. Division into classes is according by the FCI Show Regulation and is described in the registration form. In case there is no copy of a certificate approving the fulfilment of the conditions for entering working class or champion class is attached to the entry form, the dog will be put into open class. The organizer of the show is not responsible for any damages caused by the dog or by the exhibitor neither for death nor for loss of the dog. Dogs with cropped ears are not allowed into the show grounds and will not be judged. Changes in exterior of a dog performed by means of excessive use of lacquer, powder, hair tinting and basic trimming connected with a long-time tying-up of the dog on a table are forbidden at the show. The violation of these rules can lead to disqualification of the dog. Owners of the dogs awarded the title BOB (Best of Breed) are obliged to participate with their dogs in the final competitions. The exhibitors are obliged to abide with the provisions of the FCI Show Regulations, of these propositions and the instructions of the Show Committee, to which they bind themselves by submitting the entry form. They are also obliged to maintain the exhibition area clean. In case the show does not take place for objective reasons, the fees would be used for covering the show preparation expenses. It is forbidden to bring puppies for the purpose of sale to the show. The organizer does not accept any responsibility for undelivered applications.

Veterinary rules

- all participating dogs must be clinically healthy
- the dogs do not need certificate of clinical health examination any more
- dogs must have pet passport or veterinary certificate with valid vaccination against rabies.
- dogs coming from EU member states and from third countries must have a valid EU pet passport and must fulfil the conditions laid down by the EU Regulation 998/2003 of 26.5.2003.

- All the time during the dog show the owners must supervise / take care of the dogs so that they do not cause any damage to other dogs or humans

<u>Instructions for filling the entry form</u>

Entry forms should be filled out using a typewriter or in block letters. For each dog, a separate entry form should be filled out. Illegible applications will not be accepted. The discount for the second and additional dogs may be applied only if the name of the owner is the same as for the first dog. Any change in the second entry form, e.g. addition of joint ownership, will be considered to be a new entry at full cost. The organizer does not accept any responsibility for an incorrectly filled-in entry forms. A copy of the pedigree must be attached to each application form. Unless a photocopy of Working or Champion Certificate (the examination certificate, not tables and exam confirmation or Championship Certificate for the Champion class) is enclosed the dog will be classified to the open class. In the case of an imported dog, the abbreviation of the original studbook and the original registration number must be written in the entry form as well. A dog can only be entered into one class. Moving dogs between classes is not possible after the deadline. Accepting of the entry form will be confirmed 7 days before the show by e-mail. Documents required for participation in the show

FCI pedigree or studbook confirmation that this pedigree is garanted, valid vaccination passport of the dog or its EU Pet passport with valid vaccination.

Protest

A protest against any decision made by the judge is not admissible. A protest can be submitted for formal reasons such as violation of show regulation provisions and proposition provisions. The protest must be submitted in written form, against a deposit of 40 Euro, during the course of the show. If the protest is found to be unjustified, this deposit will be forfeited to the organizer of the show.

Titles

CAJC – male and female in the youth class awarded excellent 1.

CAC – male and female in intermediate class, open, working and winner class – awarded excellent 1.

Res.CAC – male and female in intermediate class, open, working and winner class – awarded excellent 2

Best of Juniors BOJ – the title obtains the best young male or female awarded CAJC.

Best of Veterans BOV – the title obtains the best male or female awarded excellent 1 in veteran class.

Sighhound Specialty Winner – winners from the intermediate, open, working and champion classes with CAC.

Best of Breed – The Best Youth, both Sighhound Specialty Winners and the Best Veteran

Competitions

Best Couple – a male and a female presented at the show. Dogs must not be in the ownership of one owner.

Best Kennel – minimum 3 individuals and maximum 5 individuals, which have been judged at the show and come from the same kennel and have at least two different fathers or mothers. These individuals may not to be owned by the breeder.

Child and a dog 3 – 9 years old - for children 3-9 years old under the Junior Handling rules.

Junior Handling 9 -13 years – under the Junior Handling rules.

Junior handling 14 – 17 years - under the Junior Handling rules.

Best from Working class - male or female awarded excellent 1, CAC in working class.

Best from Honour class - male or female awarded excellent 1, in honour class.

BIS Baby - all babies with VP1

BIS Puppy – all puppies with VP1

BIS Veteran - for all BOV veterans from the X. FCI group.

BIS Junior – all BOJ junior dogs from the X. FCI group

BIS – all BOB dogs from the X. FCI group.
