FCI EURO SIGHTHOUND (YEAR)

FCI EURO JUNIOR SIGHTHOUND (YEAR)

The minimal qualification for the 2 Titles is the note "Excellent".

Title FCI EURO JUNIOR SIGHTHOUND is allowed only in Youth class.

The 2 Titles are not cumulated.

Class winners as well as BOB winners will receive an award.

Diplomas FCI EURO SIGHTHOUND with logo FCI ESH will be given to each Winner on Saturday 1st.

By Car

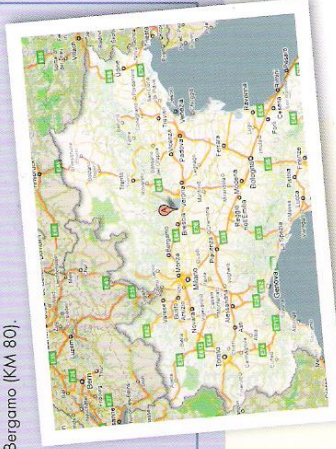

Stop at Desenzano del Garda's station (railway Milan-Venice) that have an excellent taxi service (10 min. from the venue).

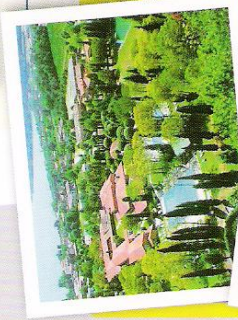
By Plane

Mascotts Greyhounds and Irish Wolfhounds – England

My affix is Mascotts and I bred my first litter of Irish Wolfhounds in 1986. Together with my partner Dave, we have a large kennel of Irish Wolfhounds and Greyhounds and we run a very busy Canine Hydrotherapy Centre in Kent. I have owned and bred top winning Irish Wolfhounds and Greyhounds in the UK. Dog Showing is my passion and I show the dogs extensively in the UK, France, Belgium, Holland, Luxembourg, Germany and Northern and Southern Ireland. I have judged Irish Wolfhounds since 1989. I first awarded CC's in 1999 and I also judge Greyhounds and Borzoi at Championship level, and the other Hound breeds at Open level. In September 2007 I judged The French Irish Wolfhound Club Championship Show at Perpignan. I have also judged in Northern Ireland. I am a committee member of The Greyhound Club.

FlicFlac Whippets – Germany

I have been actively involved with Whippets for over 25 years. It was the breed's athletic and functional beauty which has attracted me to it. As often happens, owning one or two or more of them just doesn't seem enough. Consequently, a small number of litters have been bred under my prefix FlicFlac (co-owned with Reinhard Seim) since the latter half of the 1980s. I have had the privilege of seeing and judging this lovely breed in good numbers virtually in all corners of the world. In the show ring, a dog's overall breed type, soundness and general impression is of paramount importance to me. I am already much looking forward to judging Whippets on Lake Garda in 2011

Della Bassa Pavese Irish Wolfhounds - Italy

I have got my very first dog at the age of 6, a Whippet, and I have owned West Highland Terriers and bred Irish Wolfhounds, Giant and Miniature Schnauzers and Gordon Setters. I have been breeding Irish Wolfhounds together with my mother under the "Della Bassa Pavese" affix since when I was 10 years old. This affix belongs to the Salamon family since 1973 and has bred and campaigned 40 Champions, so we can say that I have grown up with Irish Wolfhounds from the age of 5 and I'm running the kennel since 1986. From 1993 I'm also breeding Gordon Setters together with my husband, Dr. Michele Ivodi, under the prefix "Iudstar". With my Gordon Setters I've got a big number of Champions, including 15 World Winners, 3 UK Show Champions and 2 BOB winners at Crufts. Passed to judge Irish Wolfhounds since 1999 at championship show level, then I took the four Setter breeds and more recently all the FCI Group X. I've judged in Italy at National, Club, Specialty and International Show level, and in Australia, Canada, Czech Republic, Great Britain, France, Germany, Hungary, Sweden and Switzerland.

Des Monts Valdai Borzoi's - Belgium

I'm a Borzoi Breeder since 1970. I've bred many Champions, as World Champions, FCI European Champions, International, Belgian, German, French, Dutch, Swiss, Italian, Austrian ... Champions. I'm licensed to judge since 1979 and I am a Sighthounds specialist.

I have been organizing many Dog Shows in Belgium among them the FCI EURO SIGHTHOUND SHOW 2007. I'm also Secretary-general of the FCI EUROSIGHTHOUND Committee. I'm member of the Committee of the Royal Belgian Kennel Club (Société Royale Saint-Hubert) since 1981 and, presently, President of the Royal Belgian Sighthound Club (founded 1902).

Mata Salamata Salukis – Germany

Dogs have always been part of my life and I have been involved with dogs since early childhood. I saw my first Saluki at a dog show in the 60's and fell in love with this ancient breed. I knew, if I ever could have a dog of my own, it had to be a Saluki! In 1976 my husband and I acquired our first Saluki. That was the beginning of my life with Salukis, Jakob Pribil and I co-own the Mata Salamata kennel. I'm licensed to judge Salukis, Sloughis, Azawaks and Afghan Hounds. I have judged Salukis at major events and Saluki Specialties worldwide. I'm interested in all aspects of the Saluki and I want to see a functional Saluki, full of type and beautiful to look at. I'm looking forward to judge again in Italy.

Mr. Ramon Podestà

von Haussman Afghans – Chile

I'm an all breed judge since 1978. Primary breed is German Shepherd. I had been involved in many different breeds as I have the record of champions and Top Dog in the country including Latin-American, International, American (A.K.C.), English, Swedish, Spain and World Champions also. I'm the Breeder owner of the N° 1 all breeds dog in the country in 26 different years and with the following breeds: German Shepherd, Doxshund Standard, Irish Setter, Old English Sheepdog, Pekinese, Miniature Poodle, Chow-Chow, Shih Tzu, Doberman, Poodle Standard, Maltese and Afghan Hound. I had been judging in several countries I all the five continents, including World Dogs Show in Argentina, Brazil, Croatia, Slovenia, Puerto Rico, México, Austria, Finland and Portugal. Also Royal Shows in Australia and Asian International Shows in different occasions. I was President of the Chilean Kennel Club more than once, as well as member of Scientific Commission of the F.C.I since 1993 to 2001.

Mr. Jarmo Vuorinen

Scheik's Pharaos and Whippets – Finland

I have been interested about dogs all my life. When I was 15 year old, I bought my first own dog which was an Afghan male. 1977 I purchased my first Pharaoh Hound from Sweden. Since then I have bred 13 litters and there are 33 champions in those litters. I have got Finnish Kennel Clubs and Finnish Sighthound Clubs breeders awards. It was 1989, when I bought my first Whippet. It was intention to buy only one whippet, but this first one took my heart and I find out that Whippet is my breed. I have bred so far eleven Whippet litters. Over the years I have been very active in breed clubs. At the moment I'm honorary president of the Finnish Pharaoh Hound and Ibizan Hound Club and president of the Finnish Whippet Club. I have also worked many years in the Finnish Sighthound Club and I'm also member of the Turku International Dog Show committee. I have approved to judge at Championship Show level in 1994 and I'm now approved to judge all the Sighthound breeds and many others: I have judged of course many times in Finland, but also in Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Slovakia, Hungary, Germany, Belgium, Switzerland, Ireland, Great Britain, Latvia, The Netherlands, Czech Republic, France, Lithuania, Russia and Australia.
